4. Last Meetings minutes:

5. Communications: Jason Graham returned with sign up sheets for Civil Air Patrol mock training. Dates are as follows:

- June 27th @ 6pm Life Link is offering a landing zone class. Please attend this if possible. It'll help on the training days. (I missed location of class, please reach out to Darryl or Jason for that information)
- July 13th @ 9am? at Summit. Mock incident: Downed aircraft on pioneer trail.
- July 20th @ 9am at Summit. Mock incident: ATV crash
- Starting training off with a briefing. Darryl will be IC. We will be split into teams: Search, Fire, EMS, helicopter. Each team will do its part from start to finish. Load up the victims and shut down. There will be a meet and greet with the flight crew. If you're interested in being a victim, let Darryl or Jason know. You can attend either or both.

7. Chiefs Report:

- There will be events on that calendar that need participants to sign up for. Please help out if you can. Black River raceway needs 1 person for standby. Most Saturdays, but there are some during the week. Please commit ASAP so Darryl knows if he needs to reach out to other depts for their help or not.
- The FAP grant allows the dept to put money towards trainings, aids, classes, and equipment, as needed for the department. Darryl's request to replace 2 trailers with 1 has been approved through the FAP process, he will present to the board the departments choice, at the next board meeting. The department looked at the options presented and decided the most effective and efficient trailer option would be a 20' aluminum bed, dual axle trailer from Pete's Trailers out of Rice Lake.

b. **FIRE-**

- The house at the end of Jake Schmit road is available for a search and rescue training. Just need to set a date.

- There are cars behind the hall available for extrication training if you would like to utilize them when you are available. See Darryl first to make arrangements.

9. Maintenance:

- UTV & Hall was completed
- Pump 1 back in service
- E2's \$0.97 piece has been replaced and working again. Manifold drain was being repaired as we speak and should be done by tonight. (June 10th)

- UTV passenger door is missing but it is still in service.
- Brian will be working on the fender of the trailer as well.
- Darryl will look into getting a new maintainer.
- E1 has a modified handle. It was tested and tested good. But should it get stuck, there is an Allen wrench on top for a quick fix if needed. If that happens please let Brett know.
- Any and all stuff found on apparatuses or equipment, PLEASE do the following: write it on the white board, put it on the inspection sheet, and let Darryl or Brett know ASAP so they can work on getting it replaced. Thank you.

- Make sure all necessary apparatuses are out before going to a scene in POV. We need our equipment to do the job.
- If you do drive your own vehicle, safe parking is beyond the scene on the same side of the road as apparatuses. Let the engines and tenders be the shield for your vehicle if need be. People get hyper focused on the bright flashy lights at incidents and do not see other obstacles in the way.
- Rtac 63 is the preferred channel for life link and when patching out to MN depts.
- Protocol: Answer page and then switch to GGFire 1.
- Review: power line calls- MUST have PPE. No exceptions. Fire dept is *usually* only needed for traffic control, securing the scene, and scene safety, while waiting for the electric company to declare the scene safe. Full gear is necessary incase of unexpected situational scenarios.

12. Old Business:

- Drone Update: everything needs to be itemized. Brett is waiting to hear back for a quote.
- No update on the tanker or back wall.
- Summit FD trucks are still down. 1 tanker is available.

12. New Business
